

#### Fluvanna County Fair Rules

- 1. Anyone, regardless of residency, may exhibit at the Fluvanna County Fair, except where indicated.
- 2. Exhibitors assume all risks of damage or loss to person or property for any cause whatsoever. It is expressly understood The Fluvanna County Fair Board incurs no liability or obligations to the exhibitor, other than permit the exhibitor to use the grounds for tents for exhibits.
- The Fluvanna County Fair Board reserves the right to refuse any entry offered and to require removal from the grounds.
   The Fluvanna County Fair Board also has the right to deem unfit for display or competition any animal or exhibit.
- 4. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the fairgrounds except those served in the Beer Garden area during Friday and Saturday listed hours. Alcohol possession outside of roped off areas is grounds for immediate dismissal from the fairgrounds. Must be 21 or older to consume alcohol in the Beer Garden.
- 5. Posting and carrying signs or handing out literature shall be restricted to vendor space only. No roving vendors or solicitation will be allowed on the fairgrounds. This includes the parking area. Sponsors and vendors are allowed to display signs and literature at their approved space only;

- provided the signs are not offensive. The Fluvanna County Fair Board has the right to ask for removal of said signs and dismissal from the grounds.
- 6. All complaints must be presented in writing to the Fluvanna County Fair Board no later than 30 days prior to the last day of the Fair. All complaints will be reviewed and all decisions are final.
- 7. NO PETS except for service animals are permitted. Please clean up after your service animal.
- 8. No littering. Please use designated trash receptacles.
- **9.** All participants must exit the premises at the close of the Fair unless otherwise authorized.
- **10**. Please park your vehicle in designated areas only.
- 11. Access to most park areas will be made available during fair hours. Contact FCPR at (434) 589-2016.
- 12. No overnight camping authorized.
- 13. No open fires.
- **14.** No smoking in 4-H Livestock areas or in buildings. Please refrain from smoking in crowded areas.
- **15.** The Fluvanna County Fair Board reserves the right to change or revise any rules, regulations, or schedules.



#### Corn Hole Tournament

#### Rules & Regulations

- A team has 5 minutes to report to course when called.
   Failure to report in that time will forfeit the match.
- This is a family-friendly event. Please refrain from inappropriate language and observe the rules of good sportsmanship at all times.
- 3. First team to 21 points wins. (meeting or exceeding)
- 15 minutes per round unless otherwise stated. If a score of 21 has not been reached by then, a sudden death throw off will ensue.
- 5. Cancellation scoring will be used.
- 3 points will be scored for a bag in the hole, 1 point will be scored for a bag on the board.
- Rock-Paper-Scissors or a coin toss will be used to determine which team throws first, and which side a team will use when there are no seedings available.
- 8. Team member must be directly across from their partner when throwing (not criss-cross)
- The first side of players alternate pitching corn bags until they have thrown all 4 bags, then the remaining players (pitching from the other corn hole platform) continue to alternate in the same manner.
- The team who scored in the preceding inning shall pitch first in the next inning.

- 11. Contestant shall deliver corn bags from assigned position (directly across from their partner).
- Contestants not pitching shall not make distracting sounds or movements while opponents are pitching.
- 13. The pitcher must remain behind the front of the board during the entire address and release of the corn bag.
- 14. Any corn bag that leaves a contestant's hand once the final forward swing of the delivery process has started shall count as a pitched corn bag. A corn bag that is accidentally dropped by a contestant before the final forward swing has started shall not be considered foul and may be picked up and pitched.
- 15. A contestant's corn bags shall be called foul if the contestant removes any bag before the scoring of that corn bag has been agreed upon. A judge shall be called if a decision cannot be reached. The judge shall determine the scoring for that inning.
- 16. Any corn bag that contacted the ground before coming to rest on the board is touching the ground in any way shall be called foul and removed from the board.
- 17. OFFICIALS HAVE THE FINAL SAY.
- 18. Most important HAVE FUN!!!!
